

Admission Requirements and Prerequisites

To be eligible for admission to the *Master of Science, Speech-Language Pathology* degree program, applicants are required to have a baccalaureate degree in the arts or sciences with an overall undergraduate and foundational coursework GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.

Required **prerequisite coursework** includes:

- Statistics (this must be a stand-alone course)
- Biological sciences
 - Biology, Human Anatomy and Physiology, Neuroanatomy and Neurophysiology, Human Genetics, or Veterinary Science

Required **foundational coursework** (minimum of accreditation from the American Speech-Language

- Anatomy and Physiology of the Spe
- Speech and Language Development
- H0 Td&peech and Language

All materials pertaining to the application will be submitted through CSDCAS. Required elements of the CSDCAS application will include timed video and written responses. Applications must be **verified** by 11:59 PM ET on February 1
